

Guidelines for hotel accommodations starting November 06th 2021

Starting November 06th 2021 all overnight guests must be either fully vaccinated*, recovered** or show proof of a negative corona-test result***.

The corresponding evidence in the form of the vaccination certificate / test result must be presented to the hotel on arrival and will be recorded and stored in accordance with the German data protection laws.

***Guidelines for corona-tests:

Vaccinated * and recovered ** persons and children up to their 6th birthday are exempt from the test obligation

A negative PCR-test result is required starting November 06th 2021, depending on local 7-day incidences and hospitalization rates. If arriving guests cannot show the corresponding documentation, access may not be granted. Please reach out to the hotel prior to arrival concerning the current test obligations.

A self-test carried out on site under supervision with regard to an infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus is not possible at our hotel.

For longer stays in accommodation establishments, a new test must be submitted every 72 hours - however, if the local "Corona-Incidence" lies below 35 only one test must be submitted upon arrival.

If the required evidence cannot be provided, or if the corona test result is older than 48 hours prior to check-in, accommodation is not permitted. The hotel's obligation to accommodate the guest therefore expires automatically; the guest's payment obligation is based on the cancellation guidelines listed in the booking confirmation (max. 24 hours before arrival).

* Guests who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with a vaccine approved in the EU, who have written or electronic proof of vaccination in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish.

Persons are considered to be fully vaccinated if at least 14 days have passed since the final vaccination.

In order to be accommodated, both recovered and vaccinated people must not show any typical symptoms of infection with the SARS-CoV2 coronavirus. They must also not have a current proven infection with the SARS-CoV2 coronavirus.

** Guests are considered to have recovered if they have written or electronic proof of the presence of a previous infection with the SARS-CoV2 coronavirus in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish. The underlying testing must have been carried out using a PCR method and must have been performed at least 28 days, but no longer than 6 months ago.
